PAIN MEDICATION:

Injectable pain medication will be administered to minimize pain and discomfort for ~48 hours after surgery. The injection will be given at an additional cost (\$10-\$27.50) based on your pet's weight.

PRE-ANESTHETIC BLOOD WORK:

Anesthesia can cause kidney, liver and gastrointestinal toxicity. To minimize potential complications, we recommend in-house blood work to provide the best care possible. Before placing your pet under anesthesia, the veterinarian will perform a physical exam. Blood work can uncover internal abnormalities that cannot be detected from the physical exam alone. The liver, kidneys and lungs are the main organs by which anesthetic agents are metabolized and cleared from the body. Blood work includes checking liver/kidney enzymes, glucose and electrolytes to identify any existing medical conditions that could complicate the procedure and put your pet at risk. These tests are encouraged in all pets to obtain a baseline if your pet becomes ill in the future, and are **STRONGLY recommended in all patients over 6 years of age.**
